Crimes of the Sasquatch: Book I of The Sasquatch Series

- 1. The book begins with a scene of a boy in a car with a man. After reading that chapter, what did you think happened to the boy?
- 2. Dylan Cox and his cousin Nate Stewart have a strange relationship.
 - a. Do you know anyone who has had an addictive/toxic relationship?
 - b. If so, were they ever able to fully break away from the addictive person?
 - c. Did Dylan's three acts of defiance at the end of the book mean he had finally overcome his toxic relationship with Nate?
- 3. Do you feel Dylan is a good detective? Why or why not? Can you name another character in the book who has better detective skills than Dylan?
- 4. Merle and Erle Hodges are both committed Sasquatch believers. But they support the idea differently. Why do you think they approach the subject in different ways?
- 5. A few crimes in the book are unresolved by the end (e.g., the several human deaths, animal deaths, and a fire). What or who do you believe committed those crimes?
- 6. Jen Rickard says Dylan should treat Augie like anyone else, and Dylan argues that it is okay to recognize and respect Augie's differences. What do you think of their divergent opinions?
- 7. During the middle of the investigation, Dylan starts to suspect Jesse Steadman of being involved in Trip's disappearance. Was Dylan justified in his suspicions? If so, why?
- 8. What do you think of Jesse leaving behind his father Kirk Steadman and the town where he grew up?
- 9. Law enforcement kept information from Dylan about the meth lab investigation and Destiny Stewart's location. Do you believe their secretism was warranted?
- 10. What do you think Kate Meyers saw in her backyard?
- 11. Why do you think Dylan's parents never told him about his adoption?
- 12. What did you like best and least about this book?
- 17. What do you think of the book's cover? How well does it convey what the book is about?
- 18. What do you think the author's purpose was in writing this book? What ideas was she trying to get across?
